

GOD SPEAKS

JESUS IS NOT THREATENED BY OUR DOUBTS; HE MEETS US IN THEM AND CALLS US TO TRUST IN HIM.

1. THE OF THE DISCIPLES. 19 Then, the same day at evening, being the first day of the week, when the

Then, the same day at evening, being the first day of the week, when the doors were shut where the disciples were assembled, for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood in the midst, and said to them, "Peace be with you." When He had said this, He showed them His hands and His side. Then the disciples were glad when they saw the Lord. I So Jesus said to them again, "Peace to you! As the Father has sent Me, I also send you." And when He had said this, He breathed on them, and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven them; if you retain the sins of any, they are retained." *John 20:19-23*

2. THOMAS' DOUBT AND HONEST

²⁴ Now Thomas, called the Twin, one of the twelve, was not with them when Jesus came. ²⁵ The other disciples therefore said to him, "We have seen the Lord." So he said to them, "Unless I see in His hands the print of the nails, and put my finger into the print of the nails, and put my hand into His side, I will not believe." *John 20:24-25*

3. JESUS _____ THOMAS WHERE HE IS.

²⁶ And after eight days His disciples were again inside, and Thomas with them. Jesus came, the doors being shut, and stood in the midst, and said, "Peace to you!" ²⁷ Then He said to Thomas, "Reach your finger here, and look at My hands; and reach your hand *here*, and put *it* into My side. Do not be unbelieving, but believing." ²⁸ And Thomas answered and said to Him, "My Lord and my God!" ²⁹ Jesus said to him, "Thomas, because you have seen Me, you have believed. Blessed *are* those who have not seen and *yet* have believed." *John 20:26-29*

GOD INVITES

As we finish today, remember, Thomas demanded proof, but what he received was something even greater—a personal encounter with the risen Jesus. And in that moment, his doubt turned to devotion, his uncertainty to belief. And in return Jesus spoke a blessing that reached far beyond that room, extending to every believer who would come after: "Because you have seen me, you have believed; blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed." John 20:29

That blessing is for us. We have not stood in that room or touched His scars, yet we believe. We trust in the testimony of Scripture and the work of the Holy Spirit in our lives. As Paul reminds us, "We walk by faith, not by sight." And Jesus assures us that our faith is not in vain—He is near, even when we struggle to see Him.
