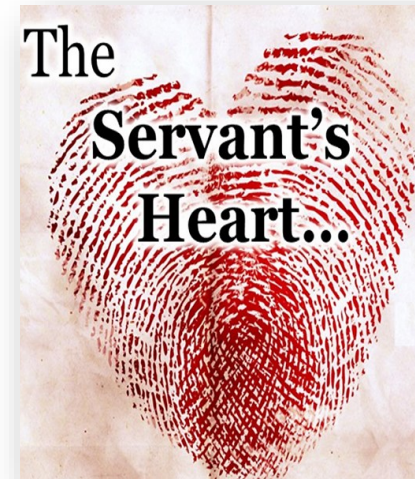

Let a man so consider us, as servants of Christ and stewards of the mysteries of God. <sup>2</sup>Moreover it is required in stewards that one be found faithful. <sup>3</sup>But with me it is a very small thing that I should be judged by you or by a human court. In fact, I do not even judge myself. (*I Corinthians 4:1-3*)

<sup>4</sup>For I know of nothing against myself, yet I am not justified by this; but He who judges me is the Lord. <sup>5</sup>Therefore judge nothing before the time, until the Lord comes, who will both bring to light the hidden things of darkness and reveal the counsels of the hearts. Then each one's praise will come from God. (*I Corinthians 4:4-5*)

<sup>6</sup>Now these things, brethren, I have figuratively transferred to myself and Apollos for your sakes, that you may learn in us not to think beyond what is written, that none of you may be puffed up on behalf of one against the other. <sup>7</sup>For who makes you differ *from another*? And what do you have that you did not receive? Now if you did indeed receive *it*, why do you boast as if you had not received *it*? (*I Corinthians 4:6-7*)
