1. _____ JESUS CAN _____

“As Jesus approached Jericho, a blind man was sitting by the roadside begging. When he heard the crowd going by, he asked what was happening. They told him, ‘Jesus of Nazareth is passing by.’ He cried out, ‘Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!’” *Luke 18:35-38*

2. _____ THE NEGATIVE VOICES.

“Those who led the way rebuked him and told him to be quiet, but he shouted all the more, ‘Son of David, have mercy on me!’” *Luke 18:39*

3. _____ FOR GOD’S CALL.

“Jesus stopped and said, ‘Call him!’ So they called to the blind man, ‘Cheer up! On your feet! He's calling you.’ Throwing his cloak aside, he jumped to his feet and came to Jesus.” *Mark 10:49-50*
