The “so what” of this message is simple. Because God has been unreasonably generous to you, now you are blessed to be inexplicably generous to others.

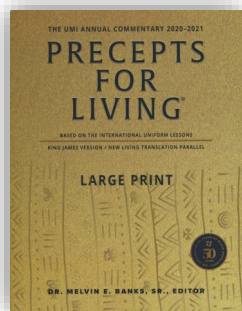
Maybe you can do something nice to someone who has wronged you in the past. Maybe you can be generous to someone who has no ability to reciprocate.

**1. _____: IT'S NEVER TOO LATE TO
COME TO GOD.**

⁶ And about the eleventh hour he went out and found others standing idle, and said to them, 'Why have you been standing here idle all day?' ⁷ They said to him, 'Because no one hired us.' He said to them, 'You also go into the vineyard, and whatever is right you will receive.' (Matthew 20:6-7)

2. _____: ALL WHO RESPOND TO GOD'S INVITATION WILL RECEIVE ALL THERE IS TO RECEIVE!
