# GOD SPEAKS

# 1. A FAITHFUL \_\_\_\_\_ FOR GOD.

<sup>12</sup> So he sent and brought him in. Now he *was* ruddy, with bright eyes, and good-looking. And the LORD said, “Arise, anoint him; for this *is* the one!” <sup>13</sup> Then Samuel took the horn of oil and anointed him in the midst of his brothers; and the Spirit of the LORD came upon David from that day forward. So Samuel arose and went to Ramah. **1 Samuel 16:12-13**

## 2. FACING WITH FAITH.

<sup>38</sup> So Saul clothed David with his armor, and he put a bronze helmet on his head; he also clothed him with a coat of mail.  
<sup>39</sup> David fastened his sword to his armor and tried to walk, for he had not tested *them*. And David said to Saul, "I cannot walk with these, for I have not tested *them*." So David took them off. <sup>40</sup> Then he took his staff in his hand; and he chose for himself five smooth stones from the brook, and put them in a shepherd's bag, in a pouch which he had, and his sling was in his hand. And he drew near to the Philistine. 1 **Samuel 7:38-40**

### 3. NAVIGATING BY FAITH.

<sup>2</sup>Then it happened one evening that David arose from his bed and walked on the roof of the king's house. And from the roof he saw a woman bathing, and the woman *was* very beautiful to behold. <sup>3</sup> So David sent and inquired about the woman. And *someone* said, "*Is* this not Bathsheba, the daughter of Eliam, the wife of Uriah the Hittite?" **2 Samuel 11:2-3**

## 4. A HEART OF IN FAITH.

<sup>7</sup> Then Nathan said to David, “You *are* the man! Thus says the LORD God of Israel: ‘I anointed you king over Israel, and I delivered you from the hand of Saul. <sup>8</sup> I gave you your master’s house and your master’s wives into your keeping, and gave you the house of Israel and Judah. And if *that had been* too little, I also would have given you much more!’ **2 Samuel 12:7-8**

**5. WORSHIPING GOD IN FAITH AS A \_\_\_\_\_.**

And the LORD struck the child that Uriah's wife bore to David, and it became ill. <sup>16</sup>David therefore pleaded with God for the child, and David fasted and went in and lay all night on the ground. **2 Samuel 12:15-16**

# GOD INVITES

David's life teaches us that God uses imperfect people for His perfect purposes. He looks beyond our mistakes to the condition of our hearts. Today, let us recommit to seeking God wholeheartedly, trusting Him in our battles, repenting when we fail, and worshipping Him with passion.
