WHEN IS WAITING PATIENTLY AN ACT OF FAITH?

1. WHEN CIRCUMSTANCES ARE _____.
“Be PATIENT, my friends, until the Lord comes back. Remember how patient farmers are as they WAIT for their valuable crops to mature and ripen. They also WAIT PATIENTLY for the spring and fall rains to do their work. You too must be patient! Don't give up, because the Lord could arrive at any time!” *James 5:7-8*
